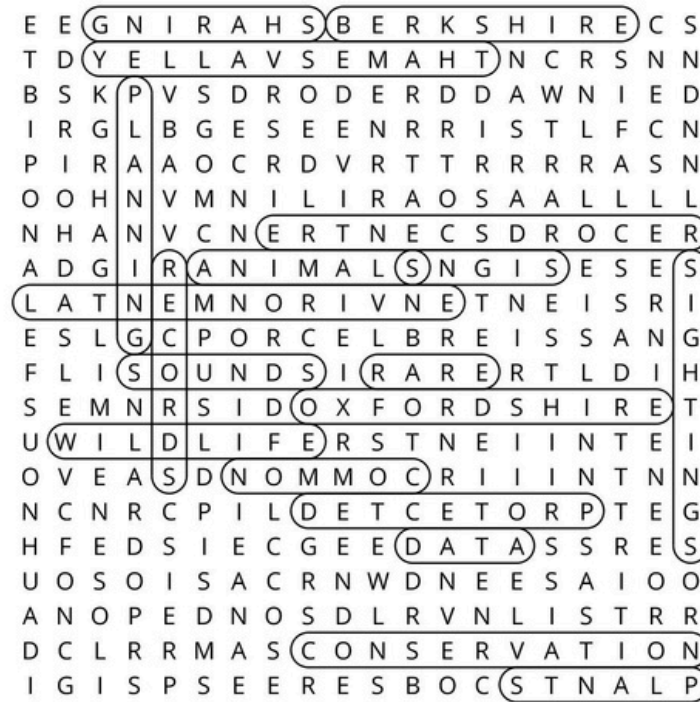

TVERC Word Search Definitions

- Animals:** Living organisms that are part of the natural environment and are often recorded for biodiversity monitoring.
- Berkshire:** One of the counties covered by TVERC, where environmental data is collected.
- Common:** Animals or plants found or living in relatively large numbers; not rare.
- Conservation:** The protection and management of biodiversity, habitats, and natural resources.
- Data:** Information collected about species, habitats, and environmental conditions.
- Environmental:** Relating to the natural world and the impact of human activity on its condition.
- Oxfordshire:** Another county served by TVERC, where environmental records are gathered.
- Planning:** The process of managing land use, where environmental data is used to inform decisions.
- Plants:** Flora recorded as part of biodiversity surveys and conservation efforts.
- Protected:** Species or habitats that are legally safeguarded due to their ecological importance.
- Rare:** Species or habitats that are uncommon or declining, often prioritized in conservation.
- Records:** Documented observations of wildlife and habitats, forming the core of TVERC's work.
- Records Centre:** A facility like TVERC that collects, manages, and shares environmental data.
- Sharing:** The act of distributing environmental data with stakeholders such as councils, planners, and researchers.
- Sightings:** Observations of wildlife, often submitted by the public or professionals.
- Signs:** Indicators of wildlife presence, such as tracks, droppings, or calls.
- Sounds:** Audio cues used to identify species, especially birds and bats.
- Thames Valley:** The geographical area covered by TVERC, encompassing parts of southern England.
- Wildlife:** All non-domesticated living organisms, including animals, plants, fungi, and microorganisms.
